What are Shelly -Ann Fraser-Pryce's achievements?

At the 2008 Beijing Olympics, Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce became the first Caribbean woman to win gold in the 100m.

In 2020 she won a silver medal at the Tokyo Olympics, becoming the first athlete to win a medal in the 100m at four consecutive Olympic games.

Shelly-Ann Fraser Pryce is one of the most decorated athletes in history, winning ten gold and four silver medals. She is the only person to win five world titles in the 100 m-in 2009, 2013, 2015, 2019, and 2022. In 2023 she won the Laureus World Sports Award for Sportswoman of the Year.
