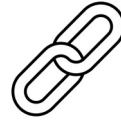

Autumn Term - Buddhism, Islam and Christianity.

Year 4 - The Journey of life and death and investigate, celebrate and visit.

Key Knowledge: Pupils will learn why Muslims, Christians and Buddhists see life as a journey. To experience and investigate Christingle and Dharma Day.

Spring Term - Buddhism, Islam and Christianity.

Year 4 - Symbols and religious expression and investigate, celebrate and visit.

Key Knowledge: Pupils will learn about why people go on pilgrimages and the rituals and practises that occur. To experience and investigate Ramadan and Wesak.

Autumn Term - Buddhism, Islam and Judaism,

Year 6 - Teaching wisdom and authority and investigate, celebrate and visit.

Key Knowledge: Pupils will investigate how and what we can learn from words or wisdom. To experience and investigate Dharma Day and Passover.

Spring Term - Islam and Christianity.

Key Knowledge: Pupils will learn about the statistics of Islam and Christianity in the local area, region, national and world. To experience and investigate Easter and Ramadan.

Summer Term - Buddhism, Judaism, Christianity and Humanism.

Year 6 - Beliefs in action in the world.

Key Knowledge: Pupils will learn about the spiritual concepts of justice, fairness, compassion and responsibility. They will also learn about the persecution and discrimination and Jewish people living in Germany in the 1930s.
