Important information for pupils and parents about Mobile Phones in School

In the past two weeks we have had an increasing amount of incidents in school with regard to mobile phones being used inappropriately before school starts or keeping them on their person. Children are not following the rules of handing phones to the office the minute they arrive at school.

After Easter therefore no mobile phones are allowed in school. If there is a particular reason a child needs to have their phone with them, then this will need to be brought to the office immediately on arrival, with a letter signed by the parent with the reason for that day. A separate letter will need to be brought each day and one will not suffice for a whole week or longer. Phones in school without a parental letter will be confiscated and will need to be collected from the office by an adult. Parents who consent to a child bringing a phone into school will need to accept responsibility if their child uses it inappropriately on the way to and from school.
