## Y6 Transition

Transition days for Y6 pupils going to city schools are on the Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July and Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July. Secondary schools will inform parents of the arrangements for each individual school. If your child is to transfer to a county or independent school then the dates may be different. Again, you will be notified of these dates by your new secondary school. If your child is not attending a transition day then they will be expected to attend school. They must go to the secondary school on those days in Melbury uniform. Children should not come to Melbury first.

## Transition

Teachers will begin to visit their new classes after half term. Children will then join their new class teachers from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July to Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July in the mornings only. They will return to their current teachers in the afternoons. This should enable teachers to really get to know the children and vice versa before they start in September. We have found that this also reduces any anxieties that your child may have about moving up. We will let you know which teacher your child will have next year shortly after we return from the half term break.
